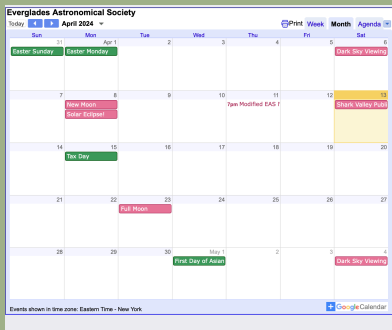
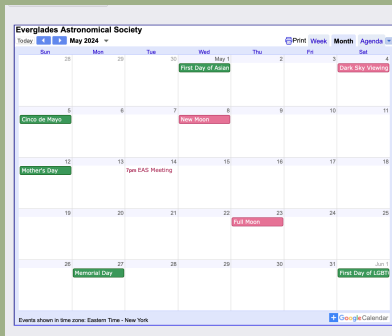

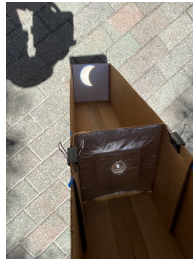

The last day of the workshop there will be a tour of the Richard F. Caris Mirror Lab on the campus of the University of Arizona. The lab makes giant lightweight mirrors for new generation telescopes.
